



NSSAF Three Year Eligibility Rule Appeals

September 2012

A student shall be eligible for three consecutive years beginning the first year of high school (Grade 10).

i) In exceptional circumstances a school may request that a year of eligibility be re-instated. In order for a school to appeal for consideration, the student must have:

- a) not competed in any NSSAF sanctioned activities in the year in question, and
- b) lost the majority of the school year in question as a result of injury or illness (medical documentation required).

*** For purposes of this Regulation, the majority of the lost year shall be interpreted as not having attended more than 50 school days.

- ii) Under no circumstances shall a student be granted a fourth year of participation.
- iii) Students who participate in Department of Education approved International Exchanges shall not lose a year of eligibility.
